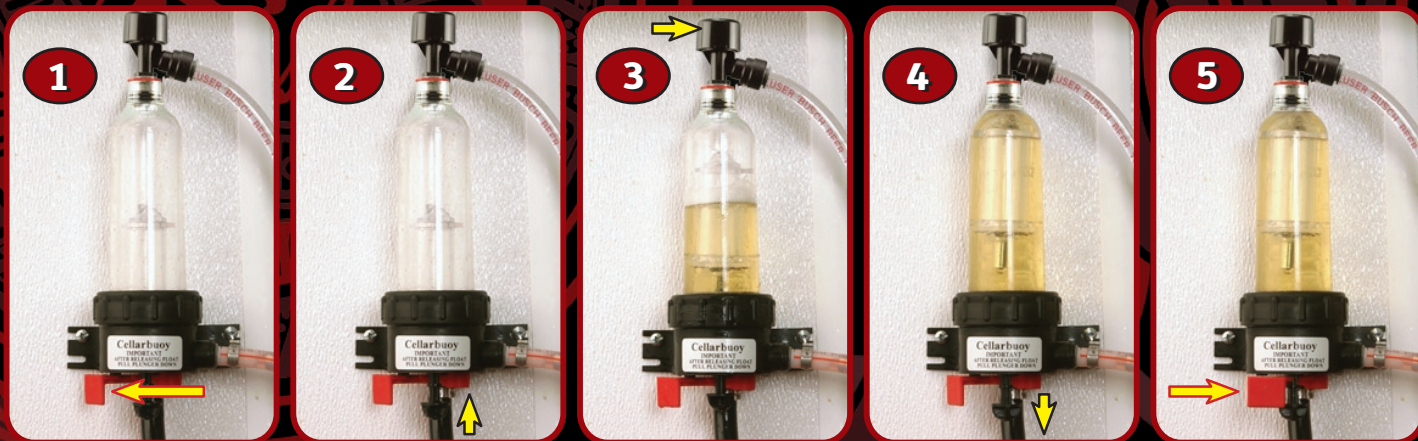


FOB BUTTON VALVE



WHEN THE BEER FLOW SLOWS OR STOPS

- Disconnect the tap from the empty barrel and connect to the full barrel in the usual manner.
 - (1) Slowly move the cleaning clip to the left.
 - (2) Push the plunger knob up to lift the inner float off its seat.
 - (3) Push the top bleed valve button down slowly, slightly bleeding off excess gas until the chamber is completely filled with beer.
 - (4) Once the float has reached the top, release the bleed valve button and pull the plunger knob back down.
 - (5) Move the cleaning clip back to the right, locking the plunger.
- If beer does not flow at the faucet, repeat steps above.

BEER LINE CLEANING

- Move the cleaning clip to the left (1).
- Push the plunger up (2).
- Move the cleaning clip back to the right, locking the plunger (5).
- Clean lines.
- Tap barrels following procedures given on top of page.
